## Media Inquiry from BBC sponsored documentary

### Project looking to speak with those under 18 at time of attacks

Prospect Pictures LTD, an independent production company in the UK, has been asked by the BBC to speak to young people who were directly affected by September 11, 2001. The documentary will investigate how the tragic event influenced the course of their lives, eight years on. As part of their research, they are looking to speak with anyone who was under the age of 18 at the time and who lost someone close to them, someone who witnessed and survived the attacks or was involved in the rescue operation in some way. They hope that this project will highlight not just the long-term emotional effects of 9/11 and the continuing need for support, but also the ways in which young people have been inspired by both their experiences and by lost loved ones to show enormous courage and go on to achieve great things.
